This Anawim Housing project was awarded tax credit funding from lowa Finance Authority and will serve seniors in the neighborhood by providing them an affordable, accessible and quality place to call home. We will begin accepting applications by Thanksgiving.

NEW PROJECTS — EXTENDING OUR REACH

Anawim is proud to be part of three Low Income Housing Tax Credit awards this year that will provide new housing units for over 150 families throughout Iowa. The projects awarded include Aberdeen Apartments in Sioux City, The Kingston Apartments in Cedar Rapids, and The Washington Apartments in Ottumwa.

Aberdeen - Sioux City

The Aberdeen apartments are the conversion of the former Central Annex in Sioux City which was utilized for athletics for the former Central High School most recently as a trade training center for the Sioux City Community School District. Aberdeen will feature 48 one and two bedroom apartments with interior parking facilities. The project is utilizing not only Low Income Housing Tax Credits but State and Federal Historic Tax Credits. Anawim is partnering with Arch Icon Development and Midwest Housing Equity Group, This will be an exciting and unique project that will help a severely strained housing market in Sioux City.

Kingston & Washington - Cedar Rapids & Ottumwa
The Kingston and Washington Apartments will be new
construction projects in partnership with TWG
Development. Both projects will provide 52 units of
one, two, and three bedroom apartments for rent in
Cedar Rapids and Ottumwa.

We are excited to pursue the mission of Anawim to other parts of the state and serve more lowans that need access to affordable housing. These projects will allow Anawim to utilize the funds derived to strengthen our financial footing and provide more and better services to those in need right here in Des Moines. With the addition of these projects, Anawim will now be able to provide homes to over 1,000 households in lowa. We can truly be proud of our accomplishments that we are able to undertake at the blessing of our supporters


