ANAWIM PROGRAM NEWS

Anawim Housing's program team has been hard at work! Director of Program Services, Cynthia Latcham, and Program Manager, Dan McBee presented at the 2018 Iowa/Nebraska Homelessness Symposium in late June. Their presentation, which also included Margo Miller from Primary Health Care, discussed the Housing First model which is utilized in Anawim's Programs. This was a means to help spark collaboration between area service providers to find ways to better help our most vulnerable homeless population, right here in Iowa.

Anawim is also pleased to announce that in July we were the recipient of \$60,000 in funds from The Polk County Housing Trust Fund which will go directly to supporting and sustaining our Shelter Plus Care program.
